1. Minutes of 7thth January 2021 meeting

2. Facebook page and Instagram (discussion) - Gracie and Lily

Notes we should link the website to the Instagram page. Asks if GT members could send in content to an email address. Eleanor

Concern about the security and privacy of future social media action and the long-term strategy for contacting members. Would prefer a conversation about this before approving. Maggie
